

RoHS Statement

Date: 22nd March 2021

In 2006, the European Union passed the Restriction of Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS) Directive into law. Effective July 2006, the RoHS Directive (2002/95/EC) banned the sale of all new electrical and electronic equipment that contains more than designated maximum allowable levels of;

Lead < 1000 ppm
Mercury <1000 ppm
Cadmium <100 ppm
Hexavalent Chromium <1000 ppm
Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB) <1000 ppm
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE) <1000 ppm
Decabromine Diphenyl Ether (DECA BDE) <1000 ppm

In May 2011, an updated RoHS2 directive (2011/65/EU) added new categories to the list of affected end products, but the list of restricted substances and permitted levels was not changed. An amendment in March 2015 added a further 4 substances and becomes effective July 22nd 2019. This is commonly referred to as RoHS3.

Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) <1000 ppm
Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) <1000 ppm
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) <1000 ppm
Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) <1000 ppm
